Overview of Optical Splitters

An optical splitter, also called a fiber splitter or beam splitter, is a passive optical device that divides a single input optical signal into multiple outputs or combines multiple inputs into one output without requiring external power. They are essential in Passive Optical Networks (PONs), enabling cost-efficient distribution of signals from a central Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to multiple Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) in FTTH deployments. Key performance metrics include split ratio, insertion loss, and uniformity of output power.

Classification by Manufacturing Technology

1. Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) Splitters

- **Manufacturing Process:** PLC splitters are fabricated using semiconductor lithography on a quartz substrate, creating a micro-scale optical waveguide array.
- **Configuration:** Commonly available in $1 \times N$ or $2 \times N$ configurations, where one or two inputs are split into multiple outputs.
- **Advantages:** High uniformity, low insertion loss, compact size, and excellent reliability across a wide range of wavelengths.
- **Applications:** Ideal for large-scale networks with high split ratios (e.g., 1×32 , 1×6 ...
