A Packet Transport Network (PTN) is a network layer set between IP services and the underlying optical fiber infrastructure. It is designed to handle the burstiness of packet traffic while ensuring reliable transport over optical networks. PTN combines the flexibility of packet switching with the high bandwidth and performance of optical transport, making it suitable for modern telecom and data networks .

- **Scalability:** Modern PTN equipment can support large capacities, for example, up to 12.8 Tbps in high-end platforms, and can be deployed in aggregation, core, or back...
