

Optical modules on data switches



Article Overview

Optical modules are pluggable devices that convert electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, enabling high-speed data transmission in switches and data center networks.

Function and Structure

An optical module acts as a photoelectric converter, operating at the physical layer of the OSI model. It converts electrical signals from a switch into optical signals for transmission over fiber, and converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals for the switch to process. The main components include:

- Optical transmitter (Tx): Uses a laser diode (LD) or LED to emit modulated light signals.
- Optical receiver (Rx): Uses a photodetector to convert incoming light back into electrical signals.
- Driver and preamplifier circuits: Control signal modulation and amplification.
- Connector and shell: Provide mechanical protection and interface with the switch port.
- Latch and dust plug: Ensure secure connection and prevent contamination.
