Evolution of Fiber Types

In the 1980s, single-mode fiber optic jumpers were introduced, allowing longer-distance transmission with minimal signal loss . Multi-mode fibers, which had larger core diameters, were also developed for shorter-distance applications such as local area networks and in-building installations . The fibers were typically reinforced with aramid yarns (Kevlar) and protective jackets to enhance durability and prevent physical damage .
