

Pakistan Optical Cable Construction Plan



Article Overview

Pakistan is expanding its optical fiber network through cross-border projects with China and a nationwide five-year fiber expansion plan to enhance digital connectivity and ICT infrastructure.

China-Pakistan Cross-Border Fiber Optic Project

The China-Pakistan Fiber Optic Cable Project is an 820 km optical fiber line connecting Khunjerab Pass on the China-Pakistan border to Rawalpindi. Initiated under the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC), the project was financed with a \$44 million concessional loan from China and implemented by Huawei Technologies. Construction began in 2015, with groundbreaking in Gilgit in May 2016, and the project was completed and inaugurated in July 2018 by Prime Minister Nasirul Mulk . The cable traverses Gilgit-Baltistan (466.54 km), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (287.66 km), Punjab (47.56 km), and Islamabad Capital Territory (18.2 km), with plans to extend to Gwadar and Karachi, forming a north-south digital corridor . This project provides Pakistan with an alternative international gateway, reducing reliance on undersea cables near Karachi, improving latency, cybersecurity, and redundancy, and supporting 3G/4G services in northern areas .
