- Pre-wired connectors: Passive boxes typically feature M8 or M12 I/O ports for sensors and actuators, which are pre-configured to reduce wiring errors .
- Open-end control cables: Some models include open-end cables for flexible integration into existing systems .
- LED indicators: Integrated LEDs for system supply and port status help with troubleshooting and monitoring without additional tools .
- 2-, 3-, or 4-wire configurations: Supports various sensor types, including PNP and standard 2-wire devices, ensuring compatibility with a wide range of industrial equipment
