

Photovoltaic Cable Tray Wiring Rules



Article Overview

PV cable tray installations must comply with NEC and IEC standards, ensuring proper support, separation, mechanical protection, and environmental resilience for long-term safety and performance.

NEC Requirements

The National Electrical Code (NEC) provides detailed guidance for PV cable tray installations:

- Section 690.31(C) allows the use of small conductors like PV wire and DC generator cables in cable trays, specifying how to calculate ampacity, the number of conductors, and tray sizing by width and layering .
- NEC 2025 updates emphasize mechanical protection, proper support spacing, and shielding from UV, abrasion, and heat. Exposed single-conductor cables must be secured frequently, and AC and DC conductors must remain separate to prevent interference and overheating .
- Cable trays must be non-combustible, corrosion-resistant, and rated for outdoor use when carrying PV conductors .

IEC Standards

International standards complement NEC requirements:

- IEC 62930 specifies low-voltage DC cables for PV systems, requiring tinned copper conductors, cross-linked insulation (XLPE), and robust outer sheaths
