

Place sockets in the distribution box

Sockets in a distribution box are connected via dedicated MCBs or fuses, with proper wiring, grounding, and labeling to ensure safety and compliance.

Planning Socket Circuits

When placing sockets in a distribution box, each socket or group of sockets should be connected to a dedicated sub-circuit. Typically, domestic installations use 13A radial circuits for general-purpose sockets and 16A circuits for high-power appliances like air conditioners . Determine the number of sockets per circuit based on expected load to avoid overloading the MCB.

Selecting Circuit Breakers

- Single-pole MCBs are commonly used for individual socket circuits.
- Double-pole MCBs may be used for special appliances requiring both phase and neutral protection .
- Ensure the MCB rating matches the load: 13A for standard sockets, 16A for high-power devices.
- Include an RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) for protection against leakage currents and electric shocks, typically rated at 30mA for domestic circuits .

Wiring Sockets to the Distribution Box

- Turn off the main power before starting any wiring.
- Run sub-circuit cables from the sockets to the distribution box. Use the correct wire gauge: for 13A circuits, 2.5mm² copper wire is standard; for 16A circuits, 4mm² ma...
