Use UL-listed, tray-rated power cables such as Type TC or MC, installed in properly supported and segregated cable trays to ensure safety, EMC compliance, and reliable operation in communication equipment rooms.

Types of Power Cables

For cable trays in communication equipment rooms, the most commonly used power cables include:

- **Type TC (Tray Cable):** Factory-assembled cables with two or more insulated conductors under a non-metallic jacket, rated for 600 volts. Suitable for industrial power or control circuits, flame-retardant, and UL-listed for use in cable trays, raceways, and certain outdoor locations. TC cables can also be used in Class 1, Division 2 hazardous locations and may include TC-ER (Exposed Run) cables for short unsupported runs to equipment .
- **Metal-Clad (MC) Cables:** Provide additional mechanical protection with a metallic sheath, suitable for 600-volt power circuits and often used where physical protection is required . All cables should be UL-listed and marked as cable tray rated, ensuring compliance with flammability, mechanical, and temperature standards.
