

Precautions for Fiberglass Cable Trays



Article Overview

Proper installation of fiberglass cable trays requires careful planning, load assessment, secure support, corrosion and fire protection, and adherence to standards to ensure safety and longevity.

Planning and Routing

Before installation, review construction drawings and conduct on-site inspections to determine the tray route, layer structure, installation height, and support spacing, adjusting for site conditions such as underground shafts, elevated supports, or chemical equipment areas . Indoors, it is recommended to install trays along walls, columns, beams, or floor slabs whenever possible to optimize support and accessibility . Pre-measure bends, ramps, and T-junctions to ensure smooth cable routing.

Load and Support Considerations

Calculate the weight per unit length to ensure the tray's load-bearing capacity matches the number and type of cables, preventing deformation or loosening . Support spacing for FRP trays typically ranges from 1.5 to 2 meters, depending on load and installation type (wall-mounted, column-mounted, or suspended), . After cable laying, deflection should not exceed $1/200$ of the span, or $1/150$ if the span is ≥ 6 meters .
