

# Precautions for installing outdoor cable trays



## Article Overview

Outdoor cable trays must be installed with proper material selection, structural support, grounding, weather protection, and adherence to safety standards to ensure reliable and safe operation.

### Material Selection and Environmental Considerations

Choose materials that resist corrosion and environmental degradation. Galvanized steel is suitable for general outdoor use, aluminum is lightweight and corrosion-resistant, and stainless steel is ideal for highly corrosive or high-humidity environments . Cable trays should be equipped with UV-resistant covers or ventilated louvers to protect cables from sunlight and rain . Avoid installing trays under corrosive pipelines unless a corrosion-resistant partition is used, maintaining a minimum distance of 500 mm .

### Structural Support and Layout

Ensure the tray has sufficient rigidity and strength to support the cable load. The deflection of the tray after cable installation should not exceed  $1/200$  of the span, or  $1/150$  if the span is  $\geq 6000$  mm . Support spans typically range from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on cable weight and tray type . Trays should be mounted on walls, columns, or beams, and coordinated with civil structures. Avoid placing trays directly below pipelines carrying corrosive gases or liquids ....
