

Primary Distribution Box Circuit System Diagram



Article Overview

A primary distribution box distributes incoming power to multiple circuits using a main switch, protective devices, busbars, neutral and earth bars, and outgoing feeders.

Overview

A primary distribution box serves as the main point where electrical power from a substation or main supply is received and distributed to various circuits. It ensures safe and organized power flow while protecting circuits from overloads, short circuits, and faults. Typical components include:

- Main Switch/Isolator: Controls the incoming supply and allows complete disconnection for maintenance.
- Busbars: Conductors that distribute power to multiple outgoing circuits.
- MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers): Protect individual circuits from overcurrent.
- RCCBs/RCBOs: Provide protection against earth leakage and residual current faults.
- Neutral Bar: Distributes the neutral connection to all circuits.
- Earth Bar: Provides grounding for safety.
- SPD (Surge Protective Device): Protects against voltage surges and lightning strikes.
