

Principle of Flow Acquisition Splitter



Article Overview

A flow acquisition splitter divides a single source of flow into multiple independent outputs, allowing precise control of flow rates to each outlet without altering the source concentration.

Basic Principle

A flow acquisition splitter operates by taking a single input flow—such as oxygen from a concentrator, cylinder, or wall supply—and distributing it to multiple outputs. Each output has an individual flow regulator, which allows the flow rate to be adjusted independently for each recipient. The total flow from the source is split according to the settings of these regulators, ensuring that each patient receives the intended flow without affecting the oxygen concentration from the source .

Mechanism

Internally, a flow splitter contains tubing and valves that channel the incoming flow to separate ports. The flow typically starts at the central inlet and is directed outward to each output. Adjustments to the flow at one port do not significantly impact the others, provided the source has sufficient capacity. Flow splitters are designed to maintain low flow rates, often ranging from 0.1 L/min to 2 L/min per port, which is particularly important in neonatal or pediatric care .
