

Problems with Directly Buried Optical Cables



Article Overview

Directly buried optical cables face hazards from environmental, mechanical, biological, and human-related factors that can compromise signal integrity and cable longevity.

Environmental Hazards

Directly buried cables are exposed to temperature extremes, which can cause expansion, contraction, or brittleness in the cable jacket, potentially leading to cracks and moisture ingress. Water penetration, especially in loose-tube designs, can freeze and expand, damaging the fiber core. Prolonged exposure to UV radiation, even underground in shallow installations, can degrade protective jackets over time, increasing the risk of signal attenuation and core damage .

Mechanical Hazards

Cables can be crushed or deformed by soil shifting, heavy vehicles, or construction equipment. Improper installation, such as exceeding bend radius limits or coiling incorrectly, can introduce microbends or macrobends in the fiber, causing signal loss. Direct burial without adequate depth or protective armoring increases vulnerability to accidental digging or excavation .
