

Protection of Austrian Secondary Distribution Boxes

Austrian secondary distribution boxes are protected through a combination of robust materials, fault detection devices, and compliance with national and European electrical standards.

Materials and Enclosures

Secondary distribution boxes in Austria are typically constructed from non-combustible materials such as stainless steel, glass-reinforced plastic (GRP), or sheet steel, ensuring durability and fire resistance . Enclosures are rated according to IP standards, ranging from IP42 for indoor use to IP66 for outdoor applications, providing protection against dust, water ingress, and environmental exposure . Micro-distribution housings often use polyurethane-based sealing foams to ensure seamless sealing of grooves and prevent moisture or dust penetration .

Electrical Protection

To safeguard against electrical faults, Austrian distribution boxes incorporate network protectors, sensitive reverse power relays, and overcurrent protection devices such as MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers), and RCBOs (Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent protection), . These devices prevent reverse power flow through transformers, restrict destructive high currents, and reduce the risk of fires or explosions caused by abnormal electrical conditions
