

Protection of Dual-Core Drop Fiber Optic Cable Splices



Article Overview

Dual-core drop fiber optic splices are best protected using fusion splice sleeves, drop wire protection tubes, and appropriate splice closures to ensure mechanical stability, environmental resistance, and long-term network reliability.

Fusion Splice Sleeves

Fusion splice sleeves are the primary method for protecting spliced fibers. They consist of an outer heat-shrinkable polyolefin tube, an inner hot-melt adhesive layer, and a stainless steel or ceramic strength member. The sleeve is slid over the fiber before splicing, and after the fusion splice is completed, it is heated to shrink around the splice, creating a secure, waterproof, and mechanically reinforced joint. This process prevents microbends, physical damage, and moisture ingress, ensuring minimal signal loss and long-term durability .

Fiber Drop Wire Splicing Protection Tubes

For dual-core drop cables, especially in FTTH installations, fiber drop wire splicing protection tubes provide additional protection. These tubes are typically made from polypropylene (PP), offering chemical resistance, insulation, and durability. They are sized to accommodate standard spliced connections (e.g., 12 mm diameter, 103 mm length) and are often housed within fiber drop boxes for organized and secure installation. They operate reliably across a wide temperature range (-40°C to 75°C) and have a lifespan exceeding 10 years, making them suitable for indoor and wall-...
