1. **Overloaded Circuits** An overload occurs when the total current drawn by devices on a circuit exceeds the breaker's rated capacity. This is the most frequent cause of tripping. Symptoms include breakers tripping when multiple high-power appliances, such as air conditioners, ovens, or heaters, operate simultaneously. Overloads generate heat over time, prompting the breaker to cut power to prevent damage or fire. To prevent this, spread high-wattage devices across multiple circuits or avoid running them at the same time . 2. **Short Circuits** A short circuit happens when a hot wire touches a neutral or another hot wire, creating a sudden surge of electricity. This can result from damaged insulation, loose connections, or faulty appliances. Signs include sparks, buzzing sounds, a burning smell, or an immediate breaker trip when turning on a device. Short circuits are dangerous and can cause fires, so they require immediate inspection by a licensed electrician . 3. **Ground Faults** Ground faults occur when electricity leaks to a grounded surface, such as a metal outlet box or appliance casing. Common causes include moisture intrusion, damaged wiring, or defective equipment. GFCI breakers are particularly sensitive to ground faults and may trip repeatedly in wet areas like bathrooms or kitchens. Installing GFCI outlets and checking appliances for damage can help mitigate this issue . 4. **Aging or Faulty Breakers** Circuit breakers themselves can wear out over time or fail due to internal...
