

Regulations for Fire Protection Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Fire protection distribution boxes must maintain electrical function during a fire, comply with national and international standards, and be tested for fire resistance classifications such as E30, E60, and E90.

Key Requirements

1. Maintenance of Electrical Function: Fire protection distribution boxes are designed to ensure that critical electrical systems—such as emergency lighting, fire alarms, ventilation, and escape route systems—remain operational during a fire. This is essential for safe evacuation and firefighting operations. The duration of maintained electrical function is typically classified as E30, E60, or E90, indicating 30, 60, or 90 minutes of guaranteed operation under fire conditions . 2. Fire Resistance and Material Standards: Distribution boxes must be constructed from fireproof materials capable of withstanding high temperatures, often up to 1,000 °C during testing. Fire resistance is evaluated according to standards such as DIN 4102 Part 12 for exterior fire protection (E-class) and DIN 4102 Part 11 for interior fire protection (I-class). These tests ensure that the enclosures maintain structural integrity and functionality during fire exposure . 3. Testing and Certification: All fire protection distribution boxes should undergo rigorous testing in accredited laboratories. Independent testers verify compliance with national and international standards, and products are issued approvals, evaluations, or test certificates. For example, OBO Bettermann FireBoxes are certified under DIN 4102 Part 12 and have general building authority certificates confirming E30, E60, and E90 classifications . 4.
