

Relay protection fails to operate under low voltage

A relay protection device may fail under low voltage due to insufficient operating voltage, contact wear, improper settings, or inadequate testing under actual fault conditions.

Causes of Failure

Insufficient Operating Voltage: Undervoltage relays are designed to trip when voltage drops below a preset threshold, typically identified as ANSI/IEEE Device Number 27 . If the supply voltage falls below the relay's minimum operating voltage, the relay may not actuate, leaving equipment unprotected . **Contact Degradation:** Used relays can develop pitting or arc residue on contacts from previous switching operations, which increases contact resistance and reduces reliability at low voltages . This is particularly critical for electromechanical relays, where low voltage may not generate enough current to close the contacts properly. **Incorrect Settings or Coordination:** Relays must be set with appropriate voltage thresholds and time delays. If the undervoltage setpoint is too low or the time delay is too short, the relay may fail to operate during a low-voltage event . **Testing Limitations:** Protection relays are primarily designed to operate under abnormal or fault conditions, not normal operating voltages. Standard functional tests at nominal voltage may not reveal failures that occur under low-voltage conditions . Digital or numerical relays with software logic may also require specialized testing to simulate undervoltage scenarios accurately
