

Requirements for bridging connections of distribution box doors



Article Overview

Distribution box doors must be electrically connected to the metal enclosure using yellow-green insulated copper conductors with a minimum cross-sectional area of 4 mm².

Material and Wire Specifications

Bridging connections between the metal door and the distribution box body must use yellow-green insulated copper wires, replacing the previously used braided soft copper wires, which are prone to corrosion and breakage, compromising grounding performance . The cross-sectional area of these wires must be at least 4 mm² to ensure reliable conductivity and grounding . All connecting wires in distribution boxes should be steel-core insulated wires, with insulation color and arrangement following standard specifications .

Installation Requirements

- Connection Method: Wire branch joints must be welded and insulated, avoiding bolted connections, and there should be no exposed live parts .
- Grounding: The metal enclosure and door must be electrically connected to the PE (protective earth) line via PE line terminal blocks .
- Compliance: Installations must adhere to the JGJ46-2024 Technical Standard for Safety of Temporary Power Supply at Construction Sites and the GB 50303-2015 Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering
