

Requirements for electrical distribution box circuits in residential buildings

Electrical distribution boxes in residential buildings must be safely installed, accessible, properly rated, and compliant with NEC, IEC, or local standards.

Key Components and Functions

An electrical distribution box, also known as a consumer unit or panelboard, is a metal or plastic enclosure that houses circuit breakers, fuses, busbars, and wiring. Its primary functions are to distribute incoming power to multiple circuits, provide overcurrent protection, and allow safe disconnection for maintenance . The enclosure protects internal components from dust, water, and physical damage, and prevents accidental contact with live parts .

Material and Protection Ratings

- **Materials:** Steel (durable, suitable for tough environments) or plastic (lightweight, suitable for indoor use) are commonly used .
- **Protection Ratings:** Check IP (Ingress Protection) or NEMA ratings. Higher ratings are required for outdoor or damp locations to prevent water and dust ingress .
- **Double Insulation:** Metallic boards must have double insulation and covers for live parts .
