

Requirements for incoming lines at the bottom of the distribution box



Article Overview

Incoming lines at the bottom of a distribution box must use properly sized, insulated cables with suitable cable glands, secure grounding, and clear separation from outgoing circuits to ensure safety and compliance.

Cable Entry and Gland Requirements

Incoming cables should enter the distribution box through heavy-duty, double compression cable glands, typically made of brass, to provide secure and reliable connections while preventing dust and moisture ingress . Detachable plates are often used to fix these cable glands, allowing for easier installation and maintenance . The cable size and type must match the load requirements, and the wires should be crimped using die-less crimping tools to ensure a strong electrical connection .

Wiring Layout

For bottom entry, the incoming lines are usually positioned at the lower part of the box, while outgoing lines may exit from the top or side depending on the design . The main circuit is generally placed on the left, and the control circuit on the right, with horizontal and vertical alignment to maintain neatness and accessibility . Proper separation between incoming and outgoing lines, as well as between different phases, is essential to prevent overheating and electrical faults .
