- Receptacles in wet locations must be weatherproof and listed for extra-duty use .
- Cables and flexible cords must be protected from physical damage and supported at intervals .
- Disconnecting switches or plug connectors are required to safely disconnect temporary circuits . While the NEC does not always mandate a box for every tempo...
