They rely on mechanical alignment and index-matching gel to connect the bare fiber to a short fiber stub inside the connector body, enabling optical signal transmission (). These connectors are widely used in FTTH deployments, emergency repairs, and small-scale installations due to their quick installation and cost-effectiveness ().

Required Tools and Materials

To properly use cold connectors, the following tools and materials are essential ():

- Fiber stripping tool: Removes the protective coating without damaging the fiber.
- Fiber cleaver: Ensures a clean, even cut for optimal alignment.
- Optical power meter and visual fault locator: For testing insertion loss and verifying connection quality.
- Alcohol swabs: For cleaning fiber ends to prevent contamination.
- Fast connectors: Pre-installed mechanical splice connectors suitable for the fiber type....
