

Ribbon core splicing with pigtail fiber

Ribbon core splicing with pigtail fiber is typically performed using mass fusion splicing, allowing multiple fibers in a ribbon to be spliced simultaneously for high-density, low-loss connections.

Overview of Ribbon Fiber and Pigtails

Ribbon fiber optic cables consist of multiple fibers arranged side-by-side in a flat ribbon format, usually in groups of 12 fibers per ribbon, though larger counts are possible (4-24 fibers per ribbon). Ribbon pigtails are short lengths of fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare ribbonized fiber on the other, designed for field fusion splicing to incoming ribbon cables. The connector end plugs into equipment or an optical distribution frame, while the bare end is spliced to the ribbon cable, providing a low-loss, permanent joint.

Mass Fusion Splicing Process

Mass fusion splicing is the preferred method for ribbon fiber because it allows all fibers in a ribbon to be spliced simultaneously, significantly reducing installation time and labor. Key steps include:

- Preparation: Strip the protective coating from the ribbon fibers, clean them, and align the fibers in the fusion splicer.
- Alignment: Use a fusion splicer designed for ribbon fibers to align all fibers in the ribbon simultaneously. Proper alignment ensures minimal insertion loss and back reflection.
- Splicing: The splicer fuses the fibers together using an electric arc, creating a per...
