Most PoE switches primarily operate at Layer 2 for switching, but some advanced models include Layer 3 routing capabilities to manage traffic between different subnets.

PoE Switch Basics

A PoE switch is a network switch that delivers both data and electrical power over a single Ethernet cable to connected devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, wireless access points, and IoT devices . This eliminates the need for separate power adapters, simplifies installation, and allows devices to be deployed in locations without nearby power outlets . PoE switches come in various standards, including IEEE 802.3af (up to 15.4W per port), 802.3at (up to 30W per port), and 802.3bt (up to 60–100W per port), depending on the power requirements of connected devices .

Layer 2 vs Layer 3 Functionality

- **Layer 2 PoE Switches:** These switches operate at the data link layer, forwarding Ethernet frames based on MAC addresses. They provide network segmentation, VLAN support, and traffic management but do not perform IP routing between subnets. Most standard PoE switches fall into this category .
- **Layer 3 PoE Switches:** Some advanced PoE switches include routing capabilities, allowing them to function as Layer 3 devices. These switches can route traffic between different IP subnets, support static or dynamic routing protocols (like OSPF or RIP), and manage inter-VLAN routing. This is particularly useful in larger networks where multiple subnets or VLANs need to communicate without a separate router
