Overview

SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules are compact, hot-swappable transceivers that convert electrical signals from network devices into optical signals for transmission over fiber optic cables and vice versa. They are widely used in data centers, enterprise networks, telecom infrastructure, and FTTH deployments. SFP modules can operate over single-mode or multimode fiber and support various protocols such as Ethernet, Fibre Channel, SONET, and CWDM/DWDM.

Single-Fiber SFP Modules

Single-fiber SFP modules, often called BiDi (Bidirectional) SFPs, transmit and receive data over a single optical fiber using Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM). This is achieved by assigning two different wavelengths: one for transmitting and another for receiving. For example, one module may transmit at 1310nm and receive at 1550nm, while the paired module does the opposite. Advantages:

- Reduces fiber infrastructure requirements by using only one fiber strand.
- Cost-effective in scenarios where fiber availability is limited or expensive to deploy.
- Ideal for long-distance single-mode applications. Considerations:...
