

Safe City Server Rack Cold Aisle Dimensions



Article Overview

A safe cold aisle in a data center should have a minimum width of 1.2 meters, with aisle lengths not exceeding 16 meters for continuous rows, and shorter lengths of 6 meters if one end is closed or lacks an exit.

Recommended Cold Aisle Width and Length

For optimal airflow, equipment access, and personnel safety, cold aisle widths should be at least 1.2 meters, allowing two full floor tiles between cabinet fronts . This width ensures sufficient space for technicians to move safely and for cooling air to circulate effectively. Aisle lengths should not exceed 16 meters for continuous rows of cabinets. If one end of the aisle is closed or lacks a personnel exit, the maximum safe length is 6 meters to allow for safe evacuation .

Ceiling Height and Clearance

For rooms with ceiling heights above 3.7 meters, additional aisle width may be required to accommodate lifts or access to overhead systems such as lighting, fire detection, and suppression equipment . Cold aisle containment systems often include top roof panels and side panels to isolate cold air, which can be modular and adjustable to fit varying rack heights and depths .
