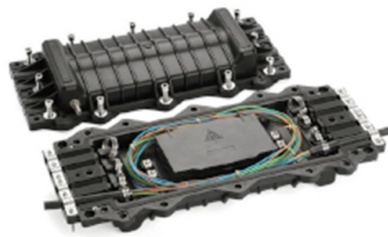


Safety Protection Measures for Optical Distribution Boxes

Physical Protection of Optical Distribution Boxes

Optical distribution boxes (ODBs) should be mechanically robust and weather-resistant for both indoor and outdoor deployment. According to ITU-T L.208, ODBs must have secure housings, proper fibre management systems, and reliable cable attachment and termination systems to prevent accidental damage and environmental exposure . Key measures include:

- Lockable enclosures to prevent unauthorized access.
- Impact-resistant materials to withstand physical stress.
- Sealed designs to protect against dust, moisture, and temperature extremes.
- Organized fibre routing to avoid bending beyond minimum bend radius and reduce stress on fibres.
