

Safety Requirements for Building Cable Trays



Article Overview

Cable tray systems must be installed and maintained according to OSHA regulations, NEC Article 392, and industry best practices to ensure structural integrity, electrical safety, and accessibility.

Regulatory Compliance

Cable trays are governed by OSHA standards (29 CFR 1910.305(a)(3)), which require employers to provide a workplace free from recognized hazards, including electrical shock, arc-flash, and fire risks . Compliance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 392 is essential for proper installation, although NEC provisions are advisory unless adopted by local law . NEC specifies that only Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables should be used, and metallic trays can serve as grounding conductors if properly installed .

Structural and Load Safety

Cable trays must be designed to support static and dynamic loads, including the weight of cables, environmental forces like wind or seismic activity, and potential maintenance loads . Key considerations include:

- Support Distance: The spacing between supports must be calculated based on tray type, cable weight, and span length to prevent sagging or failure .
- Span Distance: The distance between main upright supports should ensure struct...
