

Safety Requirements for Electrical Distribution Boxes on Construction Sites

Electrical distribution boxes on construction sites must be installed, maintained, and operated according to strict safety standards to prevent electric shock, fire, and unauthorized access.

Key Safety Requirements

Weatherproof and Protected Installation: Distribution boards (DBs) must be housed in weatherproof cabinets or enclosures to prevent water ingress and physical damage. They should be positioned to minimize obstruction and avoid interference from construction activities, and mounted on non-combustible materials such as metal frames . **Circuit Protection and Labeling:** Each circuit must have appropriate protective devices, such as fuses or molded circuit breakers, and all circuits should be clearly labeled. A circuit diagram should be displayed on or near the board for easy identification . **Grounding and Earthing:** The entire distribution system must be efficiently earthed. Earth continuity conductors, including metal conduits or cable armoring, must have sufficiently low impedance (not exceeding 1 ohm) to ensure protection during earth faults. The earth system should be coordinated with the fuse or overload ratings of protective devices . **Access Control:** DBs must be locked at all times to prevent unauthorized access. Only qualified personnel should remove covers or operate the boards . **Cable Management:** Cables from the DB to tools or equipment should be kept as short as possible (ideally under 30 meters) and routed to avoid tripping hazards. Power and lighting circuits should be separated, and cables should enter and exit boxes through insulated bushings to prevent accidental contact with...
