Understanding QSFP-DD

QSFP-DD (Quad Small Form-Factor Pluggable Double Density) is an eight-lane optical transceiver form factor designed for high-speed networks, supporting 200G, 400G, and 800G transmission rates while maintaining backward compatibility with QSFP28 and QSFP56 modules . The “double density” designation refers to the electrical interface, doubling the lane count compared to QSFP28, which allows higher bandwidth without increasing port density . QSFP-DD is widely used in data centers, AI clusters, HPC infrastructures, and backbone networks due to its high throughput and compact footprint .

Key Selection Considerations

- Form Factor and Compatibility
- QSFP-DD modules are mechanically backward compatible with QSFP28 ports, allowing reuse of existing optics in brownfield deployments .
- QSFP-DD800 modules share the same mechanical dimensions but require host ASICs with 100G PAM4 SerDes to operate at full 800G speed .
- Ensure the switch or GPON OLT supports the chosen QSFP-DD module type....
