Loose Tube Cables

Loose tube cables are the most common outdoor design. They feature fibers encased in gel-filled buffer tubes that allow the fibers to move freely, protecting them from moisture, temperature changes, and mechanical stress. These tubes are arranged around a central strength member, and the entire assembly is covered with a crush-resistant outer jacket. This cylindrical shape ensures flexibility while maintaining fiber integrity over long distances and harsh conditions, making them suitable for aerial, duct, or direct-burial installations .

Ribbon Cables

Ribbon cables group fibers into flat, ribbon-like structures, typically in multiples of 12 or 24 fibers. Multiple ribbons are stacked inside the cable to achieve higher fiber counts. The overall cable remains cylindrical, but the internal flat ribbons allow mass fusion splicing and higher fiber density, which is ideal for metro backbones or data center connections .
