

Should the neutral wire in the distribution box be installed on the left or right



Overview

Position determination: In the small power distribution unit, the neutral bar is usually located on the left side and installed on an insulated base to ensure safety.

Arrangement order: The circuit breakers should be arranged from left to right, and the reserved position is generally placed on the right side of the distribution box.

Wire color: The neutral wire is blue, and the color of the phase wire (A phase is yellow, B phase is green, and C phase is red). The neutral wire is a grounded conductor that provides the essential return path for electrical current after it has passed through a load, such as a light fixture or appliance. Prepare. Choose based on where you'll install the box. At the same time, a ground wire, which is usually a plain copper wire or occasionally, one with green insulation, is also connected to the neutral bus bar.
