

Size Standards for Optical Cable Identification Signs



Article Overview

Optical cable identification signs should follow TIA-606-C standards, using durable, machine-generated labels sized for readability and proper placement along the cable.

Label Size and Readability

Fiber optic cable labels must be large enough to be easily read without obstructing cable handling. While TIA-606-C does not prescribe exact dimensions, practical guidelines suggest text height of at least 3–6 mm for indoor cables and larger for outdoor or high-density installations. Labels should be placed 3–6 inches from each endpoint and at midpoints for runs longer than 50 feet to ensure visibility and compliance with documentation standards .

Label Materials

Labels should be durable and resistant to fading, moisture, heat, and UV exposure. Common materials include thermal transfer labels, heat-shrink tubing, and wrap-around flags. Heat-shrink tubing is ideal for permanent outdoor installations, while wrap-around flags offer flexibility for frequently changed cable paths .

Placement and Orientation

- Endpoints: Place labels 3–6 inches from connectors or termination points.
- Midpoints: For long cable runs, label at midpoints and near access panels....
