

# Standard Spacing of Cable Tray Covers



## Article Overview

Cable tray covers should maintain a minimum vertical clearance of 80 mm in concealed installations, with proper spacing to allow airflow, maintenance, and cable protection.

### General Guidelines for Cable Tray Covers

- **Vertical Clearance:** For cable trays installed in suspended ceilings or concealed spaces, the cover access side should maintain a vertical clear space of at least 80 millimeters to allow inspection and maintenance, while ensuring proper airflow for heat dissipation (Apex Tray) .
- **Top Clearance:** The top of the cable tray should maintain a minimum distance of 0.3 meters from ceilings or other obstructions to prevent overheating and allow safe access .
- **Tray Fill Rate:** The cross-sectional fill of cables within the tray should not exceed 50% to ensure adequate ventilation and prevent overheating, especially under solid covers .
- **Horizontal and Vertical Runs:** Cables should be secured at the start, end, and turns, and every 3–5 meters along horizontal runs. For vertical runs, cables should be secured at the top and every 1.5 meters .
- **Binding Spacing:** When using cable ties or bindings, the distance between ties should not exceed 1.5 meters, ensuring even tension and preventing cable sagging .
