- NEMA VE 1: Provides guidelines for tray design, material selection, and load ratings in the U.S., including deflection limits and recommended span lengths .
- UL 568: Covers safety and performance testing for cable trays in North America, ensuring compliance with fire, electrical, and mechanical requirements
