Article Overview

The center of gravity of a secondary distribution box is typically marked at the geometric center or calculated point where the box's weight is balanced, and it is represented in diagrams to ensure safe handling and transport.

Principles of Center of Gravity Marking

The center of gravity (CoG) represents the point where the weight of the box can be considered concentrated. For secondary distribution boxes, this is crucial for safe lifting, stacking, and transportation. The CoG should be indicated on at least two adjoining walls, and ideally on all four sides, using the standard symbol defined in DIN EN ISO 780 or local regulations (). This ensures handlers can quickly identify the balance point.

Load Distribution and Diagram Representation

A load distribution diagram shows the allowable position of the CoG relative to the box dimensions. For secondary distribution boxes:

- The CoG is usually near the geometric center if the internal components are evenly distributed ().
- If the box contains unevenly distributed equipment, the CoG must be calculated based on the weight and position of each component.
