Fire protection boxes are tested to maintain electrical continuity and prevent short circuits for a defined period, often up to 90 minutes at temperatures exceeding 1000°C. IEC and NEC Standards provide guidance on low-voltage distribution boxes, including proper labeling, safe maintenance access, and material selection to prevent electrical accidents. Compliance ensures that boxes are suitable for industrial, commercial, and fire-critical applications. NFPA Codes (e.g., NFPA 70, NFPA 72) outline installation and performance requirements for fire alarm and fire protection systems, including the use of dedicated distribution boxes to maintain signal and power continuity during fire events.
