

Standard for Direct Burial Depth of Power Optical Cables



Article Overview

The standard burial depth for direct-buried power and optical cables depends on cable type, voltage, and protection method, with typical minimum cover ranging from 6 inches to 24 inches for power cables and 24 inches or more for optical cables.

Power Cable Burial Depth

For direct-buried electrical power cables, the National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies minimum cover requirements in Table 300.5. Key points include:

- Direct-buried cables (e.g., UF cable) in standard trench conditions require a minimum cover of 24 inches from the top of the cable to finished grade .
- Rigid Metal Conduit (RMC) or Intermediate Metal Conduit (IMC) allows shallower burial, typically 6 inches, due to mechanical protection provided by the conduit .
- Non-metallic conduits (PVC) listed for direct burial generally require 18 inches of cover .
- The required depth may increase for higher voltage lines, areas subject to mechanical stress, or locations with heavy surface loads .
- NEC defines cover as the distance from the top of the cable or conduit to the finished surface, not the trench bottom .
