Distribution boxes and fire fighting boxes must meet fire resistance, electrical insulation, and ingress protection standards to ensure safety and functionality during emergencies.

Fire Fighting Boxes

Fire fighting boxes, such as OBO Bettermann FireBoxes, are designed to maintain electrical function during a fire, ensuring emergency lighting, ventilation, and fire alarm systems remain operational . Key standards and features include:

- **Fire Resistance Classes:** Tested according to DIN 4102 Part 12, with classifications E30, E60, and E90, indicating the duration (in minutes) the box can maintain electrical function under fire conditions .
- **Material Requirements:** Halogen-free thermoplastic housings combined with high-temperature ceramic terminals prevent toxic gas emission and ensure mechanical and electrical stability .
- **Protection Rating:** Typically IP66, providing dust-tight and high-pressure water jet protection .
- **Testing:** Fire tests simulate temperatures up to 1,000°C to verify continued electrical connectivity .
- **Installation Considerations:** Boxes are available in various sizes (e.g., T100, T160, T250, T350) to accommodate different cable cross-sections and branching requirements, with options for single or double terminals
