

Standards for adding ground wires to distribution boxes



Article Overview

Proper grounding of distribution boxes requires correctly sized copper conductors, secure connections to the box and mounting plate, and a total ground resistance below 0.1 ohm.

Ground Wire Sizing and Material

- Wire material: Use copper conductors for all grounding connections, especially for buried or exposed runs, as aluminum corrodes over time and can compromise safety .
- Wire size: In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is standard for distribution boxes, while in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is typical . For connections between mounting plates and equipment, larger wires may be required depending on cable length and load; for example, a 16 mm² wire or 6 AWG (13.29 mm²) may be used to maintain low resistance .

Connection Points

- Primary connection: Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box to the mounting plate.
- Secondary connection: Connect the mounting plate to the central factory grounding point to ensure all system components share a common ground .
- Equipment grounding: If multiple spindles or devices are connected, additional ground wires may be required between them to maintain total resistance below the...

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
