Steel cable tray removal quotas depend on tray type, size, installation complexity, and labor resources, typically measured in meters per crew per day.

Factors Affecting Removal Quota

- **Tray Material and Type** Steel cable trays, including hot-dip galvanized or stainless steel ladder and perforated trays, are heavier and more rigid than aluminum or fiberglass trays, which increases removal effort and time. The tray type (ladder, solid-bottom, or perforated) also affects handling and disassembly speed.
- **Tray Size and Configuration** Wider or taller trays, or those with multiple tiers, require more manpower and time to remove safely. Complex routing with bends, junctions, or vertical risers further reduces the removal rate.
- **Installation Environment** Indoor installations are generally easier to access, while outdoor or elevated installations may require scaffolding, lifts, or safety measures, impacting the removal quota.
- **Labor and Equipment** The number of workers, their experience, and the availability of tools (wrenches, hoists, or cutting equipment) directly influence the removal rate. A typical industrial crew can remove 10–30 meters of standard steel ladder tray per day, depending on complexity and safety requirements.
- **Additional Considerations**
 - **Cable weight:** Trays with heavy or densely packed cables require careful cable removal before tray disassembly.
 - **Supports and fasteners:** Bolted or welded supports may require extra time to detach.
 - **Safety and compliance:** Adherence to electrical and occupational safety standards can slow removal but is essential....
