Overview

A straight cable tray section is the fundamental component of a cable tray system, designed to provide a continuous, rigid support for electrical, data, and control cables. These sections are typically connected end-to-end using splice plates and supported at regular intervals to maintain structural integrity and load capacity . They are available in multiple types, including wire mesh (basket), ladder, and solid or perforated trays, each suited for specific cable types and environmental conditions .

Common Dimensions and Materials

- Lengths: Standard straight sections are commonly 10 feet (3 meters) long, though other lengths may be available depending on manufacturer and application .
- Widths and Depths: Widths range from 4 inches to 18 inches, and depths from 2 inches to 6 inches, allowing accommodation of different cable volumes and types .
- Materials: Steel (painted, black, or pre-galvanized), aluminum, and stainless steel are commonly used, chosen based on corrosion resistance, mechanical strength, and environmental exposure . Wire mesh trays are often pre-galvanized or painted for durability and grounding purposes
