

Switch Aggregation Uplink Mode Configuration



Article Overview

Switch aggregation uplink mode combines multiple physical ports into a single logical link to increase bandwidth, provide redundancy, and improve network performance.

Overview of Link Aggregation

Link aggregation, also called port aggregation, port trunking, or LAG (Link Aggregation Group), allows multiple Ethernet ports to operate as a single logical connection. This setup increases throughput, provides failover if a link fails, and balances traffic across the aggregated ports . Aggregation can be static (ON mode) or dynamic using LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol) :

- Static (ON) Mode: Ports are manually added to a group without negotiation. LACP is not required. Useful for simple setups but less flexible.
- Dynamic (LACP) Mode: Ports negotiate automatically with the connected device. LACP can operate in active (initiates negotiation) or passive (responds to negotiation) mode. This mode provides better fault tolerance and automatic configuration .

Prerequisites

Before configuring aggregation:

- Device Compatibility: Both switches or devices must support the same aggregation protocol (LACP for dynamic mode) and have compatible port speeds and duplex settings ...
