An SFP port on a switch is a modular slot that accepts optical or copper transceiver modules, enabling flexible, high-speed network connections over fiber or copper cables.

What is an SFP Port?

An SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) port is a compact, hot-swappable slot on networking devices such as switches, routers, servers, and media converters that allows insertion of SFP transceiver modules. These modules convert electrical signals from the switch into optical signals for fiber connections or maintain electrical signals for copper connections, providing flexibility in network media without replacing the switch hardware .

Optical SFP Modules

Optical SFP modules use fiber-optic cables to transmit data over long distances with minimal signal loss. They support both single-mode and multimode fiber, as well as specialized modules like BiDi optics and long-range modules capable of reaching up to 150 km . Optical SFPs are ideal for:

- Interconnecting switches across buildings or campuses
 - Linking remote network segments
 - High-speed uplinks in data centers
- The optical SFP contains a TOSA (Transmit Optical Subassembly) and ROSA (Receive Optical Subassembly) to handle fiber signal transmission and reception
