Visual Inspection

Visual inspection is the first and most critical step in fiber optic cable testing. Technicians use fiber scopes or microscopes to examine connector endfaces for dirt, scratches, cracks, or polishing defects, which can significantly affect optical performance. Inspection is performed before and after any optical measurement to prevent contamination and ensure proper mating of connectors. Video readout microscopes with software analysis are also available for more detailed inspection and productivity enhancement .

Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) Testing

OTDR testing sends pulses of light through the fiber and measures the reflected signals to detect faults, bends, splices, and attenuation along the cable. This method is essential for long-distance cables and outside plant installations, as it identifies the location and severity of events along the fiber length . OTDR testing complements other methods by providing a detailed map of the fiber's integrity.
