Safety and Regulatory Concerns

Electrical codes and OSHA regulations mandate that areas around electrical panels and distribution boxes be kept clear to ensure safe access for operation, maintenance, and emergency shutdowns. The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies minimum working space dimensions—typically 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high—to allow safe access to energized equipment . Obstructing this space with garbage violates these requirements and can result in safety citations or fines .

Fire and Electrical Hazards

Garbage, especially combustible materials like paper, wood, or packaging, increases the risk of fire near electrical equipment . Debris can also trap moisture, attract insects or rodents, and compromise seals, potentially causing short circuits, equipment failure, or electrical shock . Even non-flammable items can impede quick access during emergencies, delaying the ability to shut off power when sparks, arcing, or other electrical faults occur
