Residential optical cables are classified based on structure, core type, and installation environment, including riser, plenum, single-core, multi-core, and rodent-proof cables.

Core Types

Single-mode fiber (SMF) features a thin core (8-9 μm) that carries a single light signal, allowing data to travel long distances with minimal dispersion, making it ideal for high-speed internet and long-range connections in residential buildings .

Multimode fiber (MMF) has a larger core (50-62.5 μm) that supports multiple light modes simultaneously, suitable for shorter distances such as within a home or apartment complex .

Indoor/Residential Cable Classifications

- Riser Cables Designed for vertical runs between floors, riser cables must withstand tensile forces and support connections from entrance equipment to communication cabinets on different levels. They are typically installed in vertical shafts and are optimized for safety and durability .
- Interconnect Cables (Single-core or Multi-core) These cables are used for horizontal connections within rooms or between devices and patch panels. They feature tight-buffered fibers with high flexibility and small bending radius, making them ideal for limited space installations and direct connections to optical equipment .
- Plenum Cables Plenum-rated cables are designed for spaces with high air circulati...
