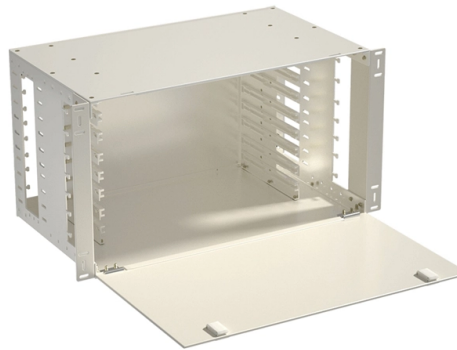


The low-voltage box needs a fiber optic cable tray

A low-voltage box requiring a fiber optic cable tray should use a solid or modular LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) tray system designed for fiber protection, proper bend radius, and EMI shielding.

Key Considerations for Selection

Cable Type and Quantity: Identify all fiber optic cables (single-mode or multi-mode) and their outer diameters. Include a 20–30% growth margin for future expansion to avoid overcrowding and maintain performance . **Bend Radius:** Fiber optic cables are sensitive to bending. Ensure the tray accommodates the minimum bend radius, especially at corners or vertical drops, to prevent signal loss or damage . **Tray Type:**

- Solid-bottom trays are preferred for fiber optics in low-voltage boxes to prevent drooping and provide electromagnetic interference (EMI) protection .
 - Modular fiber optic trays like YellowDuct® offer flexible, quick installation, and compatibility with other systems, while being halogen-free and fire-safe .
 - Perforated or ladder trays are generally used for high-voltage or heavy-duty applications but may be adapted if ventilation is needed .
- Material and Safety:** Use trays made from corrosion-resistant materials such as aluminum, stainless steel, or Noryl (recyclable plastic) for indoor or demanding environments. LSZH trays minimize smoke and toxic gas in case of fire, meeting strict safety regulations .
